Do's

- Inform your primaries if you are coming to the camp out.
- Inform your primaries of the name of all family members who will be attending camp out. If 18 or over they MUST have a background check unless they have already been established with your family.
- Inform your primaries of any food allergies.
- Inform your primaries if you need camping equipment.
- Inform your primaries of any medications.
- Provide your primaries with the day and estimated time of your arrival.
- Get directions to campout from your primary if you're not caravanning.

Don'ts

- If child is not coming with parent/guardian they must be accompanied by an adult, with approved background check and have a notarized consent form from parent/guardian. We do not want to turn anyone away.
- There will be no drinking or use of drugs during the campout. If not in compliance you will be escorted off the property.
- NO Dogs/animals allowed. Only service dogs for families.

Be sure to bring:

- Camping Gear (sleeping bag, pillow, fan, flashlights, etc.)
- Prescription medications
- Towels
- Sunscreen & Bug Repellant
- Water gun(s)
- Changes of clothes ... you will get wet!
- Swimsuit (Girls: one piece suits only please. If all you have is a two-piece, please wear a cover-up or t-shirt at all times.)
